CORPORATE CONFESSION OF SIN:

Our God, Your lovingkindness is better than life. You so loved us that You sent Your only-begotten Son to be the propitiation for our sins that we might live through Him. For the sake of Jesus Christ, Whose blood pleads better things than that of Abel’s, forgive and cleanse us from our sin! Abundantly pardon us, we pray! And, create in us a clean heart and renew a right spirit within us, binding us to walk gladly in Your Spirit always, to pour out our lives in devotion to You! In Jesus’ Name we pray, Amen.
